This week during centers we continued working on short and long vowels, reading comprehension, story writing, and sentence structure. We practiced our sight words and spelling words. We practiced ed endings on verbs to make them past tense. Next week we will be testing, so students will not have new books.

This week our vocabulary word was mend. Students have learned that the word mend means to fix something. We have discussed a variety of things that we can mend. The word mend has been added to our vocabulary notebooks. 😊

In Math we have practiced counting pennies, nickels, dimes, quarters, and half dollars. Students are really grasping this concept so we will wrap up this unit next week and move on to measurement and double digit addition.

In science we began learning about plants. We have discussed the parts of a plant and what plants need to survive. Next week we will do some experiments with plants.

The students received five new Dolch words to add to their word bag. Please be sure to practice these words each night.
