Our word of the week was bright. Students have discussed the meaning of the word bright. Students gave examples of things that are bright. We also talked about the alternate meaning of the word. The word bright has been added to our vocabulary notebooks.

In Math we have been working on place value. We have learned that every number has its own place. We have discussed tens and ones this week. We have practiced making numbers with tens and ones. We will continue this concept next week and also introduce graphing. In science we have been learning about dental health. We had some special visitors from the health department come to speak to us about caring for our teeth. We will wrap this concept up next week.
