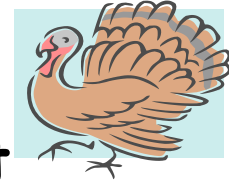


The First Grade Forecast



We have had a very busy week here at LITH. Between the snow flurries and the assemblies, the students have really been on their toes all week. We were treated to an exciting assembly today and the students really seemed to have a great time! Here are some of the other activities we have been doing this week.

This week during centers students worked on the short vowel i sound, nouns, and handwriting. Next week we will move on to reviewing all vowel sounds, more noun work, and story writing using good word choice. We will also practice our 5 new words of the week.

Our word of the week was harvest. Students have a strong understanding of this word and have brainstormed a variety of items that can be harvested. They have added the word harvest to their vocabulary notebooks.

In Math we have been working on fact families and related facts. The students have a better understanding of fact families; however practice is still needed to bring about mastery, so we will continue this next week. We will also begin geometry.

During social studies we have been discussing families and being thankful. We have talked about what it means to be thankful and students have brainstormed the many things they are thankful for. We will continue this work

next week. When students return from Thanksgiving break we will begin learning about how holidays are celebrated around the world.

The students received five new Dolch words to add to their word bag. Please be sure you are practicing these words each night. Next week we will add five new words to the word bag.

The weather continues getting much colder now, and we will be going out for recess unless the temperature reaches below 10 degrees. Please make sure that your child has the appropriate clothing for cold weather (warm coats, hats, gloves, etc). It would also be helpful if you could label their items, just in case they are misplaced. Thanks for your help. 😊
